7 Steps for using this Plugin with a WordPress Blog

# Caffeinated Content Installation

1. Download the file and unzip it
2. Look in the Links folder for: links.txt and links2.txt and edit the file if you want to generate your own links
  - If you don't want to use the links, delete the files after step 4.
3. Using an FTP program, upload to your website - put the Caffeinated content folder in: /public\_html/wp-content/plugins
4. Log into your WordPress blog
5. Activate the plug in
6. In the Settings, add your email address and registration key
7. On the Caffeinated Content Management page, select the options to get content added to your site

<b>Post category:</b>	<input type="text" value="Vintage Pens"/>	
	<i>Put posts in created categories, or in the specified category.</i>	
<b>Max tags to be automatically generated:</b>	<input type="text" value="7"/>	<b>I usually just use 7 tags, or so</b>
	<i>How many tags do you want? If left at 0, automatic tagging will be turned off, otherwise Caffeinated Content will try to pick the top tags from the returned tag pool.</i>	
<b>Max questions to add:</b>	<input type="text" value="15"/>

# Management - Details, continued

Here are some settings I use

<b>Auto approve added comments?</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<i>Checking this option will automatically approve all added comments. Be aware, however, that even if the comments are future dated, they will show up immediately. Unchecking this option will allow you to approve comments by hand through the WP comment interface...a lot of work.</i>
<b>Schedule comments?</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<i>Checking this option will cause new comments to be scheduled instead of instantly posted to your blog. Some blogs seem to have problems with comment scheduling so uncheck this if this is the case for you.</i>
<b>Add links to comment author names?</b>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<i>Checking this option will automatically add a link to every comment author's name. Good for quick undercover links...bad for targeted linking. If you select this option, be sure to fill up your link files (selected below) with LOTS of links to your personal sites to spread the link love.</i>
<b>Change comment author names to link anchor text?</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<i>Checking this option will rewrite comment author names with the anchor text in your links.txt files. Only works if you've checked the above box!</i>
<b>Links text file:</b>	<input type="text" value="RANDOM"/>	<i>If your template uses the links tag or you have selected comment author name links, this is the file that Caffeinated Content will pull it's links from. This will come in especially handy if you're using WordPress MU. These files are located at <code>/home/lovepen/public_html/wp-content/plugins/CaffeinatedContent/links</code>.</i>


